Here's how it works:

Fun Facts About Penguins

1. Spending up to 75% of their lives in water, penguins survive in treacherous habitats.
2. Penguins can be found all over the Southern Hemisphere, from as far north as the warm waters of the Galapagos Islands to the icy waters of Antarctica.
3. Emperor penguins can grow as tall as 4 feet!
4. Penguins pant to stay cool . . . just like dogs!
5. Penguins get rid of all the saltwater they ingest through a special gland behind their eyes, then they “sneeze” the water out of their beaks.
6. Most birds have hollow bones, but penguins have dense bones that makes it easier for them to dive.
7. Penguins are flightless. Nope. They can’t fly!
8. Penguins don’t have teeth. Instead, they have “spines” on the inside of their beaks and on their tongues.
9. Penguins eat small rocks! Many scientists think that this helps with digestion and may also help weigh them down while diving.
10. Penguins cannot breathe underwater!
