Forcing Firefox to save the login

- Open Firefox.
- Click on three horizontal lines to open Firefox's control panel.



• Click on Options > Security

• Click to put a check mark next to **Remember logins for sites**.

Saving your library card number in mywpl.ca

- Open Firefox to http://www.mywpl.ca/
- Enter your Card Number and PIN in the entry boxes and click Login.
 - There may or may not be a prompt to save the password during this process.
 - \circ Enterprise will open in a separate tab with you logged in to your Account.
- Within Enterprise, click Log out and close the tab.
- Return to mywpl.ca and press F5 to refresh the page.
 - Refreshing the page will allow you to test to see if your information has been saved.

Logging in using the saved library card number

- Open Firefox to http://www.mywpl.ca/
- Your library card number should be showing in the Card Number box.
 - IMPORTANT NOTE: Though the number will appear when you return to the page, if you delete the saved number out of the box, there may not be a way to recover the information without retyping it and starting the process over again.
